Money muling is a serious crime where individuals are tricked into transferring illegally obtained money on behalf of criminals. These activities are often disguised as legitimate job offers or requests for financial help, but participating in them can have severe legal consequences.

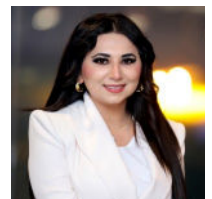

## DEDICATED SECTION TO ASLI 'S SHINING STARS



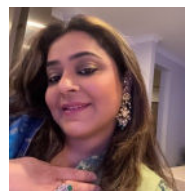
