- How to seek help in emergencies

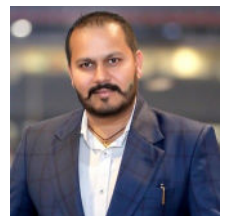
Your participation is highly encouraged, as this knowledge is not only empowering but essential for ensuring your safety and the safety of those around you.

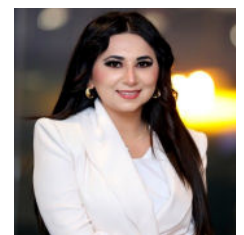

On May 8th, 2024, ASLI hosted a comprehensive student support workshop led by Y@S Accounting Taxation Services at ASLI Level 2, 123 Lonsdale Street, Melbourne. The event aimed to equip students with essential skills for lodging taxes and managing personal finances. The first segment focused on the intricacies of tax filing, providing detailed guidance on understanding tax obligations, preparing necessary documentation, and completing tax forms accurately. Because I'm the girl with wings.



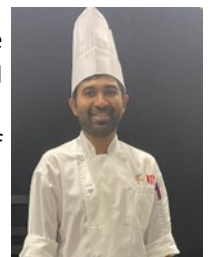
