A Tips and tricks from Cookery class

1. With the price of some produce getting very expensive, consider planting leafy greens such as lettuce or herbs which can be easily grown in planters on a balcony or a window without too much hassle.

2. Don't knock purchasing frozen or canned fruit and vegetables! This is much more cost- effective method, has extended shelf life compared to fresh produce and there is no compromise in nutritional intake. Having these products on hand is a great way to use them when required.

3. When shopping compare the price per 100g/ml between like products to get the most value. This can be really handy if you are buying proteins such as meat, poultry and fish which you can buy in bulk, portion and freeze for later use.

Always remember to label and date items before freezing.

Update Regarding English Language Requirements

Dear Students, Please note the Australian Government raised the English language requirements effective March 23, 2024 for Student and Temporary Graduate visas to enhance the educational experience and economic contributions of international students and graduates. Changes are listed below.

Student Visas

- The minimum test score for the English proficiency requirement for a Student visa increases from International English Language Testing System (IELTS) 5.5 to 6.0 (or equivalent).
- The minimum score to undertake a packaged English Language Intensive Course for Overseas Students
- (ELICOS) course increases from IELTS 4.5 to 5.0 (or equivalent).
- Students undertaking recognised university foundation or pathway programs that deliver reputable English language training require a score of IELTS 5.5 (or equivalent). These recognised courses will be listed on the Department's website.
- For students studying English only through ELICOS, there will be no change.

Temporary Graduate visas (TGV)

- The minimum score required for a Temporary Graduate visa increases from IELTS 6.0 to 6.5 (or equivalent as specified on our website), with a minimum score of 5.5 for each component of the test (reading, writing, speaking and listening).
- Passport holders from Hong Kong and British National Overseas (BNO) are not required to meet this increased minimum English language requirement. The settings for this cohort remains at IELTS 6.0 (or equivalent), with a minimum score of 5.0 for each component of the test (reading, writing, speaking and listening).
- The test validity window for all Temporary Graduate visa applications decreases from three years to one year. Applicants must provide evidence that they have completed an English Language test no more than one year immediately before the date of the visa application.

Further information about the changes will be communicated to education providers and potential applicants, including through the Department of Home Affairs website, social media channels and outreach activities.
